- Earlier, women farmers used to bring the products as head loads- hectic, especially during rainy seasons

Support to Agriculture through Irrigation and other watershed works

- Irrigation works through NREGS- real help to the farmers
- Special watershed schemes like 'bhoomikkoru kayar vastram' (coir clothes to the earth) for conservation of canals and watershed areas – helps to raise the water levels-Ground water recharging -solution to the drinking water problem also
- protection of land and water through eco-friendly materials (coir and vetiver/grass)

Irrigation works-contd.

- Irrigation works (canal maintenance) of Peechi Dam, now through NREGS (earlier, it was done by the irrigation dept)
- Hence, regular maintenance is being done
- Employment to the local people
- Water to the agriculture as well as for drinking purpose- helps to raise the water levels of nearby wells
