Roles and Responsibilities:	<p>Key Responsibilities and Activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Identification and Inclusion of Livestock Farmers Identify and include potential livestock farmers, with a special focus on vulnerable households, to promote livestock-based livelihood pathways for their economic upliftment. This includes identifying sheep and goat farmers at the village level in collaboration with Livestock Extension Workers (LEWs).• Formation and Strengthening of Livestock Producer Groups (LPGs) Mobilize identified farmers into Livestock Producer Groups (LPGs) and provide continuous handholding support to make these groups vibrant and self-sustaining. Facilitate regular LPG meetings to enable planning and execution of household-level interventions related to inputs and market access.• Support to Producer Groups Across Gram Panchayats (GPs) Provide consistent support to producer groups across all GPs within the Cluster (combining 3-4 panchayats), ensuring adherence to group norms and effective functioning.• Household-Level Data Collection and Support Facilitate the collection of household-level data through LEWs and support the implementation of sheep and goat rearing interventions at the household level.• Aggregation and Activity Planning Develop producer group-wise aggregation plans and prepare monthly activity schedules, including business generation plans tailored for each PG.• Cluster-Level Mobilization and FPC Formation Initiate cluster-level meetings of livestock farmers, with representatives from LPGs across GPs, and facilitate their organization into Farmer Producer Companies (FPCs) at a later stage.• Reporting and Financial Settlements Ensure timely submission of reports and settlement of bills at the project office.• Monitoring and Performance Tracking Track progress of activities and monitor both the quantitative and qualitative performance of community cadres, particularly the LEWs.• Gender Inclusion Promote gender sensitivity and proactively ensure the
