Roles and Responsibilities:	<p>Key Responsibilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Support the implementation of project activities related to sheep, goat, and backyard poultry rearing at the village level.</li> <li>• Help establish livestock prototypes and follow up on day-to-day work plans, identifying any gaps and finding local solutions.</li> <li>• Support and guide Livestock Extension Workers (LEWs) and Livestock Service Centre Supervisors by building their skills and monitoring their performance.</li> <li>• Strengthen Livestock Producer Groups (LPGs) by helping conduct regular meetings and supporting planning for inputs, services, and market linkages.</li> <li>• Conduct basic training and awareness sessions for livestock farmers and entrepreneurs on animal care, feeding, breeding, and health.</li> <li>• Help develop and use simple training materials and toolkits suited for farmers.</li> <li>• Assist in documenting best practices, success stories, and field learnings.</li> <li>• Build village-level systems to support farmers in getting good quality breeds, feed, and animal health services.</li> <li>• Identify and support the inclusion of marginal and vulnerable households in livestock activities for income generation.</li> <li>• Work with LEWs and LPGs to plan village-level activities and help in collecting basic household and animal data.</li> <li>• Coordinate with Gram Panchayat and Taluka-level officials to link government schemes and resources with project activities.</li> <li>• Ensure LPGs are supported with both input (backward) and market (forward) linkages for livestock.</li> <li>• Promote the use of standard practices in livestock rearing as per project guidelines.</li> <li>• Keep records of activities and submit monthly reports to the supervisor.</li> <li>• Promote women's participation in all project activities and ensure gender-sensitive practices are followed.</li> </ul>
Eligibility criteria	<p><b>Qualifications and Experience:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Educational background in Veterinary Science, Animal Husbandry, Poultry Science, or a related field from a recognized institution (including Veterinary Diplomas).</li> <li>• Candidates with a 2-year post-matriculation Livestock Supervisor certification are also eligible.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Minimum of 2 years of field-level work experience in livestock-based value chains, preferably with community institutions, Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs), or rural development projects.</li> <li>• Must be willing and able to travel regularly to villages as part of the role.</li> <li>• Owning a two-wheeler is mandatory for field operations.</li> <li>• Fluency in Kannada (reading, writing, and speaking) is mandatory.</li> <li>• Basic spoken Hindi is an added advantage.</li> </ul>
