Roles and Responsibilities:	<p>Key Responsibilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The person will be responsible for overall coordination of the project in 2-3 blocks • Engage with community institutions and internal teams to strengthen sub-sector-based livelihoods, particularly in livestock and integrated farming. • Prepare and implement production plans at household, LPG (Livestock Producer Group), and cluster levels, aligning with market demand. • Support livestock management, ensuring smooth production cycles (e.g., sheep and goat rearing), progress tracking, and timely reporting of results. • Monitor key performance indicators (KPIs) and support the project team with timely data collection, reporting, and documentation. • Liaise with relevant government departments and other organizations to explore partnerships and opportunities for collaboration. • Establish and manage learning sites/prototypes to demonstrate best practices in livestock-based livelihoods. • Facilitate market-oriented production by engaging with local institutions, stakeholders, and producer groups to develop practical business plans. • Identify and document best practices; integrate learnings into ongoing project planning. • Ensure the inclusion of marginal households in all livelihood activities, with a focus on strengthening systems and processes for scale. • Facilitate linkages with financial institutions for access to credit (assets and working capital). • Collaborate with the Marketing Manager to co-develop integrated production and market linkage plans. • Ensure gender sensitivity and promote the active participation of women in all project activities.
