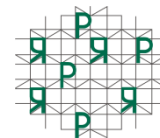


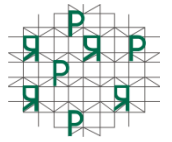

Responsibilities:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Support in planning and implementation of WASH interventions focusing on safe drinking water, sanitation, and hygiene promotion.• Facilitate capacity building of community collectives (SHGs, VOs, CLFs) and cadres through trainings, awareness campaigns, and behaviour change communication (BCC) strategies.• Engage actively with PRI members and village-level institutions to promote ownership and sustainability of WASH initiatives.• Conduct regular and rigorous field visits with strong grassroots-level engagement to ensure effective implementation and community participation.• Promote household and community-level adoption of safe sanitation practices, including usage and maintenance of toilets and solid/liquid waste management systems.• Support development and strengthening of water systems, including drinking water sources, water quality monitoring, and community-based management mechanisms.• Facilitate convergence with relevant government schemes and departments such as Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM), Health Department, and ICDS.• Build linkages with frontline workers (ASHA, Anganwadi Workers, Jal Sahiya, Swachhagrahis) for coordinated WASH implementation.• Support community-led planning for WASH infrastructure and services, ensuring inclusion of marginalized households.• Monitor water quality, sanitation coverage, and hygiene practices through regular data collection and field assessments.• Develop and promote behaviour change campaigns on hygiene practices such as handwashing, menstrual hygiene management, and safe water handling.• Ensure timely documentation including baseline and endline assessments, reports, case studies, and IEC materials.• Track progress of WASH interventions and present updates in review forums and coordination meetings.• Support development of demonstration models and pilot initiatives for replication and scaling.• Coordinate with NGOs, CSOs, and technical agencies for knowledge support and innovation in WASH practices.
